Perithemis tenera (Say) – Eastern Amberwing - common
Plathemis lydia Drury – Common Whitetail - abundant
Sympetrum ambiguum (Rambur) -- Blue-faced Meadowhawk - rare
Sympetrum internum Montgomery – Cherry-faced Meadowhawk - uncommon
Sympetrum obtrusum (Hagen)- White-faced Meadowhawk - common
Sympetrum rubicundulum (Say) -- Ruby Meadowhawk - abundant
Sympetrum semicinctum (Say) -- Band-winged Meadowhawk - uncommon
Sympetrum vicinum (Hagen) -- Yellow-legged Meadowhawk - abundant
Tramea carolina (Linn.) – Carolina Saddlebags - rare
Tramea lacerata Hagen – Black Saddlebags - common
